We know that life always has ups and downs, twists, and turns. Maybe you decided to leave decades ago or maybe it was just this morning. If you are an adult (over 18 years of age) and have not been confirmed, you may attend the Returning Catholics process this Spring and you then you will be eligible for the Sacrament of Confirmation.

How do I return?

If you simply stopped coming on your own, all you need to do is make a good confession! We offer confessions every Wednesday and Friday from 4:00 PM – 6:00 PM, or by appointment. If you would like to talk to someone beforehand, please contact us and we would be happy to help you. Do not be afraid, ashamed, or embarrassed if it has been a while and you do not really remember how to go to confession, Fr. Mark & Fr. Julio would be happy to assist you!

What if I am divorced?

What if I was baptized Catholic, but missed First Communion?
